Who answered the survey?

- 55.8% -Registered LPF Active
- 24.2%- Registered LPF NOT Active
- 20%- NOT Registered LPF

Their county affiliate status:

- 57.9% said there is an active affiliate
- 20% were unsure
- 12.6% said there is no affiliate
- 9.5% said there is an affiliate just not active
